Like many within our community I have deep admiration for what Jessica Watson has achieved this week. When she started out on her journey some seven months ago I have to admit I was one of the cynics. As a parent I could not understand how Jessica's parents could allow their sixteen year old daughter to go on a around the world journey, a journey that would force her to face numerous challenges and obstacles, many of which would be potentially life threatening. But yet they did. I saw the humour in her first attempt as she crashed into another ship, but now like many of us I have to eat humble pie and congratulate her on what is simply a wonderful achievement.

I am not attempting to write another article which waxes lyrical about Jessica and her achievements rather as someone who is passionate about education. Her story has the opportunity to teach us all so much about ourselves and what we are capable of achieving. At sixteen she spent 210 days largely alone with only her own mind keeping her sane, at sixteen she literally learnt how to tackle her problems head on, at sixteen she took responsibility for her own life, at sixteen she learnt how to turn her dreams into reality. She learnt that commitment, discipline and passion can enable you to become resilient to what life throws at you. So why don't we achieve what she has?

For many of us it is the fear of failure. We fear that we will not make it hence why should we even try. The problem with this logic is that it becomes a self fulfilling prophecy therefore we do not even try at all. But and this is a big but, what I see at Arndell are students who can achieve great things. I see students who can attain academic achievement, I see students who can pursue professional sporting careers, I see students who will become humanitarians, I see students who will pursue careers of service to others and to God and I see students who can turn their dreams into reality, if only they were willing to have commitment, discipline and passion.

As I hear our students speak I often hear their excuses, many of which are valid concerns, but the reality is so many of them can be overcome, so many of them have a solution, so many of them can be turned around if only we are willing to see this happen. We could learn a lot from Jessica's achievement and I hope we do.
