As we quickly come to the end of another term I would like to remind our college community of a few things that are happening in the life of our college;

Year 6 Camp – next week our two Year 6 classes will be going on camp to experience a wide range of activities. These camping programs are educationally designed to extend our students and enable them develop a range of life skills that will hold them in good stead for the future.
