As we are all aware over the past two years the college has undertaken a strategic restructure of its staffing and we have now come to the final element of this process. At the end of 2010 the following staff will be leaving our college and I would like to take the time to briefly thank these staff for their many contributions to the life of this college. Over the course of this term more fitting farewell comments and events will be made for these staff so we can properly acknowledge the many contributions they have all made whilst being at Arndell.

In Administration we will be farewelling Mr Leigh Windsor. Leigh has been a tireless worker in Administration and I know he is looking forward to hopefully an easier life in retirement.

In the Junior School we will be farewelling Mrs O'Hare; Mrs O'Hare has contributed in so many ways to the life of this college and she will be missed by us all. Due to continued ill-health Mrs Misztal has decided to resign from her position as both Head of Infants and as one of our Kindergarten teachers. Mrs Misztal has been a long term member of our school and over the past twelve or so years many of our children have had the positive experience of having Mrs Misztal as their teacher.

Mr Ian Finn has been appointed on a twelve month contract to teach History and assist with Careers. Mr Finn is a committed Christian and we look forward to having Mr Finn at the college and we know he will bring a great deal of energy and enthusiasm to the life of our school. Dr Sam Jackson will be joining us from Shore School to take on the role as Head of Christian Living and History. His passion for the Gospel and history will be of great benefit to us all. Mrs Amy Woodward has been appointed as our new Head of HSIE for 2011 and Mrs Elmarie Filmalter will become our Head of Science.

Year 7 for 2011 is almost full, there are two places available, and there are some places available in Years 8 and 9.
