The Australian Speech Communication Association is an organization which promotes and assists the development of oral communication, performance and listening skills in educational, professional and social spheres which are so important in our competitive world. They offer a series of finely graded examinations which challenge candidates of all ages and levels.

Through our peripatetic lessons, students at Arndell Anglican College have had the opportunity to participate in these examinations.

ASCA holds an Awards Ceremony each year to commend the students who have shown excellence through performance. Successful candidates come from many schools throughout Sydney and some travel from afar such as Canberra, Wagga, Bathurst and the northern coast.

Centre Medals are awarded to the students who have achieved the highest mark in their district. Studio Medals are awarded to the highest marks in the examination centre or school while Studio Achievements go to candidates identified by the examiner as worthy of recognition.

In 2010 we saw four Arndell students pass their Certificate of Communication [Cert. Comm. (A.S.C.A.)]. This is a professional qualification which demonstrates proficiency in oral communication. It is a culmination of many years of study in this subject and all received above 90 %.
