For many of our students who leave Arndell Anglican College the things that they remember the most are the memories they have of being involved in the many co-curricular activities that we offer. Over the past week the next sport trimester in the Hills Zone Sporting Competition has started for our senior students. This season we are fielding two rugby teams, a soccer team and four netball teams and so far we have started with some very positive results. The Junior Rugby Team won their opening game against The Hills Grammar School 46 – 3 and I want to congratulate the boys on their excellent performance. For many of these boys it was their first game of rugby and with a squad of 23 players it was a real challenge to get all of them on the field at some stage.
